DBS Study Abroad Program Weekend Field Trip Northern Ireland Itinerary



Day One

Students take a bus trip to the Antrim coast, where they can view the sweeping coastline. A visit to Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge affords stunning views of Rathlin Island and the Scottish Islands and visitors who opt to meet the challenge can cross the rope bridge. The sightseeing continues with a visit to the Giant's Causeway, a unique rock formation composed of basalt columns and UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day Two

Following an overnight stop in Derry, the second day starts with a tour of the Derry Walls, where visitors see the troubled history of the city. A visit to the Bloody Sunday Museum is also included. The group then travels to Belfast.

Day Three provides great insight into the Troubles with a bus tour of the city of Belfast including the murals on both sides of the religious and political divide as well as a visit to the Harland and Wolff Shipyard where Titanic was built.

The final day involves a brief stop at Stormont Castle, the seat of the recently-restored Parliament of Northern Ireland prior to returning to Dublin.
